Directions:

- You are to create a web that displays your skills, hobbies, interests, intelligences, values, and career interests.
- This individual web should be filled with tons of detail. When you begin building the web, start with your name in the middle, since **YOU** are the focus of this web.
- The next step would be to have the web branch out the following categories: skills, hobbies, interests, intelligences, values, and career interests. From there you should have little branches that use descriptive language (no more than 2-3 words).
- To help you with creating this web, use your self-assessment questionnaires that you completed a couple of weeks ago (for ex: Who Are You? Multiple Intelligences...)
- Once you have finished the detail in these categories, your next step is to review the eight focus areas and match them to your different categories in your individual web. (For example: under the skills section of your web you show interest in presentation skills, leadership skills, etc – you would then match up the Business and Applied Focus area—and then possibly add some more of the skills listed on the Focus area handout).
- Additionally, use pictures to help with describing different parts of your web. There should be a minimum of five pictures and a maximum of ten.

Expectations of this Assignment:

- Your in-class work habits will be part of your mark. The less effective you are in class, the more it will hurt your mark.
- There should be a great amount of detail to your web and demonstration of critical thought.
- You should address all the categories in this assignment (skills, hobbies, interests, intelligences, values, career interests).
- You should have the Focus areas that match your categories on your web.
- There should be a minimum of five pictures and maximum of ten pictures included in your web.
